## ON-FARM VETERINARY MEDICAL KIT

This is a list of supplies and basic medications that are recommended for your on-farm vet kit. While there are certainly many additional items that you may have, these are ones that most field veterinarians feel are the necessities. Always check with your veterinarian if you are unsure of usage and dosages for any medications.

Thermometer  
(quick-reading digital)  
Stethoscope

Activated charcoal  
Dosing syringe

Foal stomach tube\* (to be used **only** after veterinarian's instruction)  
Frozen colostrums (goat or cow) (must be kept frozen until use)  
16 or 18 French red rubber catheter  
Catheter tip syringe or plastic bottle

Penicillin (Procain G, 300,000 units/mL) (must be refrigerated)  
Thiamine injectable  
Banamine injectable  
Sucralfate (Carafate)  
Ivomec/Dectomax  
Safeguard (fenbendazole)  
CD/T (vaccine for *Clostridium Perfringens* types C&D & tetanus)  
(must be refrigerated)

Betadine or anti-bacterial solution  
Superglue (for closing small cuts)  
Gauze pads  
Tape  
Vet wrap
